

## **Presidential Community Engagement Task Force**

**Purpose:** To ensure that Loyola University New Orleans maintains its status as a top community engagement university, as demonstrated by its Carnegie Community Engagement Classification and its membership on the President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll.

**Goal:** Successful applications for both the Carnegie Community Engagement Classification and the President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll (PHECSHR).

**Primary functions:**

- Review the Loyola University New Orleans Annual Community Engagement Report on the university's level of adherence to the standards for the Carnegie Community Engagement Classification and the President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll (PHECSHR).
- Identify the best approaches to address the standards the university may need to improve in order to maintain its Carnegie CE classification and its inclusion in the PHECSHR.
- Monitor the resulting progress, as well as the university's maintenance of those programs, policies, and procedures for which these two important designations are awarded.
- Identify programs that could potentially be highlighted on the Carnegie application.
- Convene any capacity building workshops intended to help programs adhere to Carnegie CE standards

**Membership:** The members of the committee will include those with substantial ability to affect university programs, policies, and procedures where community engagement is concerned and should be appointed by the President of the university. Members should include, but are not limited to, the Deans of the university colleges, the Director of Grants and Sponsored Programs, a member of the University Senate Executive Committee, the Provost, the Vice President of Mission and Ministry, the Vice President of Student Affairs, Vice President of Enrollment Management, and Vice President of Marketing and Communications. Members will meet once per semester.
